District Storm Teams are monitoring Tropical Storm Erika's track. Canal water elevations are at normal stages. The District is monitoring forecasts and prepared to respond accordingly. Community internal discharge control structures should remain closed.

The District encourages communities to inspect their drainage facilities and perform any necessary flood protection maintenance.
