According to the National Weather Service, Erika has dissipated as a tropical cyclone. Tropical storm watches/warnings have been discontinued.

The District's canal elevations have been lowered and are at appropriate levels to accommodate forecasted rainfall.

**Communities within the boundaries of the Lake Worth Drainage District should begin closing any discharge control structures (weirs). All structures should be closed no later than 5:00 p.m. today, Saturday, August 29.**

The District continues to monitor the storm system and will provide additional notifications as needed.
