

Hurricane Irma Update 4 for Sep. 8, 2017

You are receiving this email because you have expressed an interest or are the designated flood control/drainage entity for your community or business.

Residential communities and businesses with operable discharge control structures may open today, September 8, 2017 from 8am to 5pm. All structures must be closed by 5pm today and remain closed during the storm.

After the storm, authorization to open may be given if conditions permit. Communication will be made by email, <u>Facebook</u>, <u>Twitter</u> and posts to our website at <u>www.lwdd.net</u>.

While structures are open residential communities and businesses must ensure they have positive outflow meaning the water is flowing toward the canal.

Residential communities and businesses should also inspect their drainage swales and storm drains to ensure there are no obstructions that will block the flow of water away from their property.
