



Hurricane Irma Update 5 for Sep. 8, 2017

You are receiving this email because you have expressed an interest or are the designated flood control/drainage entity for your community or business.

All structures must be closed by 5pm today and remain closed during the storm.

After the storm, authorization to open discharge control structures may be given if conditions permit. Communication will be made by email, [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#) and posts to our website site at www.lwdd.net.

Rainfall may raise lake levels and produce temporary flooding of streets, sidewalks and yards. Flooding in these low lying areas is expected and will help prevent flooding of homes and businesses.

Caution should always be applied when walking or driving through flooded areas. For life threatening emergencies dial 911.
