EOC Directory Update

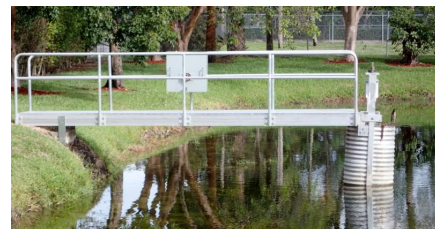
