Dear Property Owner:

As indicated in the initial notification letter both mailed and hand-delivered on May 31, 2016, the Lake Worth Drainage District (District) is scheduled to begin necessary rehabilitation work on the L-14 Canal adjacent to your property in early August 2016. This work is necessary to facilitate effective flood control for public safety and provide unobstructed access for emergency flood control response and routine canal maintenance. Rehabilitation efforts may include removal of vegetative encroachments, removal of structural and non-structural encroachments, dredging of the canal channel, and reshaping or reconstruction of the canal bank(s). Encroachments located on the District's canal rights-of-way can create obstructions to water flow during a heavy rainfall event or hinder the District's ability to properly maintain the canal, both of which can cause serious flooding issues for surrounding neighborhoods.

District surveyors were recently on-site to stake the canal right-of-way, delineate property lines and identify any vegetative or structural encroachments. Property owners have been requested to remove all encroachments and personal property within this area. Please be advised that any encroachments or personal property remaining in the right-of-way at the commencement of the project may be removed and disposed of by the District.
