LWDD Service Boundary Internal Drainage System Authorized Contacts

It is important that Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) knows who is responsible for the maintenance of your community’s internal drainage system and control structure operation. This may be one or more individuals such as: board member(s), drainage committee member(s) and/or the property manager.

There are two reasons LWDD requests this information:

- LWDD needs to verify that the individual requesting approval to open an internal control structure has the authority of the community’s Board
- LWDD needs to know where to send e-mail weather alerts and instructions
