

- Staff recommends solicitation of a formal Request for Proposals to ensure open and fair competition
- Current broker, Brown & Brown (health insurance) and Preferred Risk Insurance Agency (property,casualty) will be notified and encouraged to submit a proposal

Scope of Services



- Services will include:
 - Soliciting and negotiating annual renewals of insurance coverage
 - · Ensuring District is in compliance with healthcare reform and pertinent legislative requirements
 - Providing informational materials to employees related to enrollment activities, explanation of benefits and wellness programs
 - Routinely evaluate risks and make recommendations for the appropriate mitigation of those risks in a cost-beneficial way
 - Providing information on workers' compensation issues, trends and proposed or new legislation
 - Coordinating notice of claims and/or losses to underwriters and act as a facilitator during the claim process
